<sup>5)</sup> Other Revenue Customers are charged a flat wholesale rate per million gallons of water supplied.

<sup>6)</sup> This report includes only water supplied for which revenue is collected in accordance with existing user agreements. It does not include water utilized for system maintenance, or water provided to the McLaughlin Fish Hatchery.
